YWCA Camp Westwind provides a number of opportunities for teens to develop leadership skills, gain confidence and have fun at the same time! Throughout the summer teens have an opportunity to be involved with our family camp programs.

YWCA Camp Westwind will offer two Mother Child camps in summer 2011 —Mother Child Session 1: July 16-19, Mother Child Session 2: July 20-23 and one Father Child Camp July 8-10. At each of these sessions there are up to 10 spots for teens that will assist the summer staff in providing quality children's programs. Teens help teach activities, assist parents with children, provide cabin supervision for two hours in the evening and participate in a number of camp programs.

If you love children and the outdoors this may be a perfect fit for you. We are looking for enthusiastic teens that can commit from 3 to 5 days to a family camp program, in addition to a day long training in late June. Children's programming volunteers (aka "Babysitters") must be at least 14 years old by July 7th to apply. Teens must be good role models for campers—participating in activities, following camp rules and respecting all participants. In exchange for your commitment you will receive training, room and board, and an excellent experience along with volunteer service hours/reference.
